



# Year 3/4 Homework Expectations

Reading	Mathematics	Spelling
<p><b>Take home Reading:</b></p> <p>In Year 3/4 students are expected to read for 15mins a night, five nights a week. Evidence of this is to be recorded within the home reader record book.</p> <p>Students are expected to change their books daily (or as necessary) to ensure they are reading a variety of text.</p> <p>The record book is checked once a week by the classroom teacher to ensure that students are recording their reading.</p>	<p><b>Magnificent Mathematicians Homework:</b></p> <p>Mental mathematic skills are necessary to help build confidence to solve mathematical problems. Your child has been assessed and placed at the relevant level on the EVPS Magnificent Mathematicians Homework Program. The skills developed through the program build your child's mental mathematic skills.</p> <p>In Year 3/4 students are expected to practise their strategy 10 minutes a night.</p> <p>Testing of these strategies will occur once a week.</p>	<p><b>Magic &amp; Gemstone Words:</b></p> <p>All EVPS students are working towards completing the Magic and Gemstone Spelling Program. If your child has not completed the program they will be assigned a spelling level to work from.</p> <p>For those students who have completed their Magic and Gemstone words, they will be guided to select 5-10 words incorrectly spelt from their writing to use as their weekly words.</p> <p>In Year 3/4 students are expected to practise their spelling words 10 minutes a week using a suggested activity from the spelling strategy rubric. These activities will be checked once a week by the classroom teacher.</p> <p>Testing of these words will occur once a week.</p>

## Holidays:

- Students are not expected to complete homework during school holidays, however parents may choose to continue with the above activities.
- Students who are on extended family holidays during the term, will be provided with alternative homework.
